Biden Canceling Student Loan Debt for 153,000 People

Borrowers enrolled in the Saving on a Valuable Education (SAVE) plan are eligible to have \$12,000 in student loans eliminated, and the remaining balances will have \$1,000 eliminated for each additional year of regular payments.

President [Joe Biden announced the elimination of debt](#) for borrowers utilizing the SAVE student loan plan, [stating on X](#), “Starting today, the first round of folks who are enrolled in our SAVE student loan repayment plan who have paid their loans for 10 years and borrowed \$12,000 or less will have their debt cancelled. That’s 150,000 Americans and counting. And we’re pushing to relieve more.”

According to a fact sheet released by the White House, [millions of borrowers have no monthly payment](#). “Under the SAVE plan, monthly payments are based on a borrower’s income and family size, not their loan balance.... Already, 7.5 million borrowers are enrolled in the SAVE Plan, and 4.3 million borrowers have a \$0 monthly payment.”
