



Congressional Democrats Meeting Over Biden Candidacy Today

House Democrats are holding <u>closed-door</u> <u>caucus meetings this morning</u>, where will likely discuss President Biden's candidacy for reelection, and Democratic strategy going forward.

Yesterday, Representative Adam Smith (D-Wash.) joined with other Democrats calling for Biden to drop out of the presidential race, stating on X, "I'm calling on President Biden to step down. Furthermore, Representative Alexandria Ocasio-Cortez (D-N.Y.) told reporters she spoke with Biden, and stated he will remain the nominee: "The matter is closed, he had reiterated that this morning, he has reiterated that to the public. Joe Biden is our nominee. He is not leaving this race. He is in this race and I support him."
