



Israel Prepares for Ground Offensive in Lebanon

Israel's war Cabinet has approved the Israel Defense Forces' (IDF) next phase in its war against Hezbollah in Lebanon, according to a Haaretz report. In response to reports of the imminent IDF ground invasion of Lebanon, Hezbollah's deputy chief Naim Qassem stated, "We are quite ready, if the Israelis want a ground incursion, the resistance forces are ready for that."

The Jerusalem Post reported that IDF ground forces have <u>entered southern</u>
<u>Lebanon</u>, and IDF Arabic spokesperson
Colonel Avichay Adraee warned residents in the southern suburbs of Beirut to evacuate immediately, <u>stating on X</u>:

The IDF has not officially confirmed an invasion. Responding to reports on activity in southern Lebanon, IDF spokesman Rear Admiral Daniel Hagari <u>asked that</u> information on "activities of the forces" not be shared due to security concerns:

Good night. In recent hours there have been many reports and rumors about IDF activity on the Lebanese border. We ask not to transmit reports about the activities of the forces, due to the security of our forces. Stick to the official reports only and do not spread irresponsible rumors.
