



Jury Orders Trump to Pay \$83.3 Million in Defamation Lawsuit

Former President Donald Trump was ordered by a jury in a New York defamation lawsuit to pay \$83.3 million to E. Jean Carroll. The jury reached its verdict in less than three hours, and awarded \$65 million in punitive damages and \$18.3 million in compensatory damages.
