



Manchin Not Running for Reelection

Senator Joe Manchin (D-W.V.) announced he will not be running for reelection in 2024, saying in a video on X — "I have made one of the toughest decisions of my life, and decided that I will not be running for reelection to the United States Senate. But what I will be doing is traveling the country and speaking out to see if there is an interest to create a movement to mobilize the middle and bring Americans together." Some speculate he could possibly be planning a presidential campaign.

Democrats will face a difficult race with Republicans to retain their 51-49 Senate Majority, as Manchin is West Virginia's only Democrat in Congress. The primary Republican candidates for Manchin's Senate seat include Representative Alex Mooney and Trump-endorsed Governor Jim Justice.
