



## SCOTUS Hearing Arguments on Trump Ballot Disqualification

The U.S. Supreme Court is hearing former President Donald Trump's appeal of a December 19 decision by the Colorado Supreme Court blocking him from the 2024 Colorado primary ballot. Three of the nine justices on the Supreme Court were appointed by Trump: Neil Gorsuch, Brett Kavanaugh, and Amy Coney Barrett.
