



Slovakian Prime Minister Shot, in Life-threatening Condition

Slovakian Prime Minister Robert Fico was shot multiple times in an <u>assassination</u> attempt at a government meeting in Handlová, Slovakia earlier today. According to a statement released, "An assassination [attempt] on Prime Minister Robert Fico was carried out today at the government's offsite meeting in Handlova,"

In response to the assassination attempt on Fico, Slovak President Zuzana Čaputová stated on X:

Fico is described as a populist, and he opposed Covid-19 lockdowns in 2021. He has strongly opposed sending military aid to Ukraine, stating in a September 2023 speech:
