



## Tesla Factory Targeted by Far-left Extremists in Arson Attack

Tesla's Gigafactory in Grünheide (Mark), Germany, was <u>targeted by an arson attack</u> after an electrical substation was set on fire. Far-left activists with the "Volcano Group" claimed responsibility for the attack and released a statement.

In the statement, they <u>claimed Tesla</u>
<u>negatively impacts the environment</u>: "Tesla
consumes earth, resources, people, workers
and in return spits out 6,000 SUVs, killer
cars and monster trucks each week."

Tesla CEO Elon Musk <u>responded to the</u> <u>news, writing on X</u>, "These are either the dumbest eco-terrorists on Earth or they're puppets of those who don't have good environmental goals. Stopping production of electric vehicles, rather than fossil fuel vehicles, ist extrem dumm."
