



# Trump Appoints Pete Hegseth as Secretary of Defense

In response to the announcement, Senator Elizabeth Warren (D-Mass.) criticized Trump's nomination, calling Hegseth a "Fox & Friends weekend co-host" despite his more than 20 years of military service for which he was awarded the Combat Infantryman Badge and two Bronze Star Medal decorations. Warren stated in a post on X:

A Fox & Friends weekend co-host is not qualified to be the Secretary of Defense. I lead the Senate military personnel panel. All three of my brothers served in uniform. I respect every one of our servicemembers. Donald Trump's pick will make us less safe and must be rejected.

In response to Warren's post, former U.S. Army LTG Michael Flynn responded that Hegseth will be an excellent secretary of defense, <u>stating in a post on X</u>:
