Trump Nominates Matt Gaetz for Attorney General

Gaetz said he would be honored to serve as attorney general in Trump's second administration, <u>stating</u> in a post on X:

It will be an honor to serve as President Trump's Attorney General!

Trump's announcement reportedly shocked lawmakers. Punchbowl News' <u>Melanie Zanona reported</u> that Representative Garret Graves (R-La.), one of former House Speaker Kevin McCarthy's (R-Calif.) close allies, was clearly distraught following the announcement:

Meanwhile, Rep. Garrett [sic] Graves — a Kevin McCarthy ally — literally ran away from me and @AnnieGrayerCNN when we tried to ask him about Gaetz, grabbing another member by the shoulders to use him as a body shield to block us.

Firearms-rights organization Gun Owners of America (GOA) <u>responded</u> to Trump's announcement by noting Gaetz's 95 percent rating from the GOA:

HUGE NEWS! President-Elect Donald Trump has nominated @RepMattGaetz to be his Attorney General. Our next AG has a 95% rating with GOA & wants to ABOLISH THE ATF.

Gaetz was first elected to the U.S. House of Representatives in 2016, winning reelection four times while representing Florida's 1st Congressional District. Before serving in Congress, he served in the Florida House of Representatives, from April 2010 to November 2016. During his tenure in the House, Gaetz has earned a <u>cumulative score of 85</u> percent on *The New American's* Freedom Index.
