



Trump Returns to Site of Assassination Attempt in Pennsylvania

Former President Donald Trump is holding a presidential campaign rally in Butler, Pennsylvania, today. The event is being held at the site of the July 13 assassination attempt in which Thomas Matthew Crooks, a 20-year-old man, used an AR-15 rifle in an attempt to kill Trump. Crooks fired at Trump from less than 150 yards while Trump was delivering a campaign speech.

Corey Comperatore of Sarver, Pennsylvania, was killed by Crooks during the attempt, and two other victims were critically injured. During the assassination attempt, Trump sustained a minor wound to his ear, and shouted, "Fight! Fight! Fight!" as U.S. Secret Service agents rushed to surround him on stage.
