Trump to Remain on Illinois Ballot

Former President Donald Trump <u>will remain</u> on the Illinois Republican presidential primary ballot after a vote by the Illinois State Board of Elections. The board comprised of four Democrats and four Republicans voted unanimously, 8-0, to allow Trump to remain on the ballot.
