Long Live Freedom — and Sanity!

This week, Argentina's wild-haired and foulmouthed president went to Davos and delivered a 20-minute speech that tore into socialism and cultural Marxism. Another of the conflicts that the socialists have brought about is that of man against nature. They maintain that we human beings harm the planet, and that it must be protected at all cost, including reaping the fruits of population control, or the bloody agenda of abortion."

As my colleague Steve Bonta and I discussed on <u>Thursday's episode</u> of *The New American Daily*, it's refreshing to hear a world leader talk like a sane person. Since Joe Biden was installed in the White House, uninhibited destruction and madness has descended on the planet. Wars have erupted all over the world and the White House has been run by Marxists and mentally ill DEI hires whose presence on the national stage has demoralized the sensible Americans who keep the country running.
