Beating the United Nations

What can be said about the United Nations? Perhaps what could *best* be said was written by Robert Welch, founder of The John Birch Society. In the May 1960 *Bulletin*, he wrote of the UN, "The actual organization is hopelessly venal, immoral, and degraded at every level. It also shows — what many of us have long suspected — that the driving force behind every act and every decision of importance is a determination to help the Communists and harm their enemies."



Scratch a crisis long enough, and you're bound to hit the UN or one of its many affiliates. The steady growth of the organization is a testament to those who continue to give it credibility.

Let's make this absolutely simple: The concept of government in the "United States" is encapsulated in the Declaration of Independence — the purpose of government is to protect our God-given rights, and those united together are "Free and Independent States." The declaration absolved all allegiance to a foreign nation, and dissolved all political connections to it.

Yet, what have the American people allowed to happen? They have allowed Congress to yoke the country to the United Nations, while increasing allegiance to its anti-American agenda and establishing layer upon layer of political connections.

The UN will continue eroding the sovereignty of member countries until the fateful day when the world looks to that globalist organization for the final say in government.

That is the day the New World Order will be official.

Every dollar we give to the UN — and every law, rule, or regulation created to support the UN agenda — is another nail in the coffin of American sovereignty.

The sustainable development goals of the UN's Agenda 2030 will ensure that every aspect of your life is controlled by government. The current federal overreach under President Biden will seem amateurish compared to the tyranny that will come from the UN.

What to do? Be vigilant! Work together at the local, county, state, and federal levels. Make regular phone calls and send regular emails to keep the issue at the forefront with legislators. This is especially effective if many people do this in the same district.

Get Congress to pass the DEFUND Act to officially get the United States out of the UN and the UN out of the United States.
