Conspiracy? What Conspiracy?

Those who have been exposing the building up of the New World Order have been dubbed "conspiracy theorists." Yet, anyone with a modicum of awareness knows America is in a freefall from its lofty constitutional principles. If Americans are not freer today than they were decades ago, then something must be happening — either by accident or design.

If it were accident, then how would one account for the mountain of deliberate decisions, votes, and other factors that have gotten us to this point?

The John Birch Society has written many thousands of pages over the years documenting the design of world-government advocates. Writing in *None Dare Call It Conspiracy*, Gary Allen said, "The Insiders' code word for the world superstate is 'new world order.'... A world government has always been the object of the Communists."

Robert Welch, founder of The John Birch Society, predicted long ago that when the end game for the conspiracy closes in, its agenda will be exposed for all to see. Anyone living through the enormous government power grab due to Covid has had a front-row seat to tyranny and a taste of what world government in a New World Order would be like.

Speaking at the JBS founding meeting, Welch said, "A part of that plan [for world domination], of course, is to induce the gradual surrender of American sovereignty, piece by piece and step by step, to various international organizations — of which the United Nations is the outstanding but far from the only example — while the Communists are simultaneously and equally gradually getting complete working control of such organizations."

Over the years, these various world bodies have gained much authority over the affairs of not only member nations, but of all nations, having been led by the foreign policy and generous resources of the United States. But one organization has helped to expose this conspiracy and has thrown off its timetable by decades.

Since 1958, The John Birch Society has been actively working against the New World Order. The Council on Foreign Relations (CFR), a global-government promoting think tank, pushed hard in the first decade of the 2000s to see North America integrated into a European Union-style union. However, Robert Pastor, the CFR architect of the North American Union (NAU), wrote in one of his books in 2011 that The John Birch Society was among the leading groups that "have been the most vocal, active and intense on North American issues, and they were effective in inhibiting the Bush administration and deterring the Obama administration from any grand initiatives."

Working within a coalition of like-minded organizations, JBS helped to get anti-NAU resolutions introduced into 23 state legislatures, while also single-handedly killing off the Free Trade Area of the

Americas initiative years before, and eventually sinking the Security and Prosperity Partnership, the Trans-Pacific Partnership, and the Transatlantic Trade and Investment Partnership — each with its own timeline for integration.

One of the aspects of the conspiracy that eludes most patriotic Americans is the focus of the battle. Driven by political parties, many are led to believe that the battle is squarely within the realm of politics. Yet, working with *The New American*, the JBS has easily debunked this by publishing the voting records of congressmen, demonstrating their adherence (or lack thereof) to the U.S. Constitution. As these scorecards reflect, adherence to the Constitution isn't a foregone conclusion for Republicans (although they do generally adhere more to the Constitution during a Democratic presidency). The battle boils down to freedom vs. bondage, and no one political party holds a monopoly on either freedom or tyranny.

For the JBS, the focus of the battle has always been on exposing the conspiracy through educational means, focusing on facts (not theories), and instilling principles that allow Americans to see beyond the issues. While some currently see a bleak future, we see a bright opportunity. Never before has the end game become so apparent to so many. Never before have we had such an opportunity to find common ground with so many like-minded and concerned Americans.

An advantage to working with others on the same action projects is that local efforts get multiplied and eventually amplified throughout the nation, building influence and organization.
