JFK: Not Globalist Enough for the Deep State

As Robert Welch, founder of The John Birch Society, pointed out in 1963, the assassination of President John F. Kennedy was a product of the communist conspiracy, and those involved in this overall conspiracy are well organized and use every contrived or natural crisis to advance their mission of worldwide domination.

Longtime readers of *The New American* may remember the efforts of this magazine, along with the staff of The John Birch Society, in tracking CFR members within presidential administrations. The findings reflected an infection that had only grown worse since 1929. The only time it subsided, although not completely, was under President Trump.

The CFR publication *Foreign Affairs* carried an article by then-Senator John F. Kennedy in October 1957 titled "A Democrat Looks at Foreign Policy," which signaled his bona fides to CFR leaders and other kingmakers.

In part, he wrote, "Americans have always displayed a faith in self-enforcing moral principles and have hankered for apocalyptic solutions and fixed patterns; they must learn that most current issues in international politics do not encourage such unrealistic hopes. Many of the old conceptions of war and peace, friend and foe, victory and defeat, must be reshaped in the light of new realities."

"A pose of benign 'neutrality' or 'non-intervention' will not help us to advance the cause of our NATO allies or the Western position in general," Kennedy continued.

Once president, he used the occasion of his July 4, 1962 speech at Independence Hall to promote the idea of a future "Declaration of Interdependence" and suggested that "Americans must learn to think intercontinentally."

The European Economic Community, a precursor to the European Union, replied that it was pleased with Kennedy's call for interdependence and looked forward to the time when a unified Europe could lay the foundation for an "Atlantic partnership" that "takes into account a responsibility to the entire free world."

However, largely thanks to The John Birch Society, an Atlantic Union has not been realized, throwing off the timetable of Atlantic integration by many decades.

So, if Kennedy was supporting internationalism, why was he killed? We can see parallels in how government has been weaponized against President Trump. Both presidents appeared to be uncontrollable by the Deep State. Kennedy did not play nice with the CIA, didn't uphold the plan for a Vietnam War, didn't thoroughly execute the Bay of Pigs, and walked away from those who wanted nuclear weapons to be used. In life, his usefulness to the Deep State had peaked. His death served as a

launching pad for the communist plan of "civil rights" legislation that expanded the control and scope of the federal government for many decades to follow.

Popular novelist Taylor Caldwell warned three weeks before the assassination that Kennedy's life was in danger. She wrote, "I receive quite a number of pro-Communist and 'Liberal' periodicals [that] ... are wrathful against our President. It seems that they had expected him to overthrow the Constitution and set up a sort of crypto-Communist dictatorship. (They call it 'progress.') He has disappointed them, and there is no canard too mean for them to print and no sneer too ugly for some of their pages.... This may come as a surprise to many of my Conservative brothers and sisters. As that [Liberal] part of our national press is influenced from Moscow, it is easy to see the temper of many of them. And that temper can easily inflame madmen.... The mere thought of Mr. Kennedy being assassinated should make all of us shudder."
