## **Globalism Can Be Stopped**

It didn't take long after the 2008 global economic crises for the World Economic Forum to offer its Global Redesign Initiative, a precursor to its Great Reset plan to remake human civilization.

The Global Redesign Initiative called for greater cooperation among governments, corporations, and other "stakeholders," leading to further interdependence among countries as "economic development and integration advance[d]."

That's globalism, which has been the goal of the post-WWII rules-based international world order. Such variables as economic output, manufacturing capacity, and military strength help to determine a country's place in world leadership.

Since WWII, the United States has been *the* world leader furthering the internationalist agenda that's also being pursued by a circle of influential entities — the WEF, the Council on Foreign Relations, the Club of Rome, the Bilderberger Group, the European Union, NATO, and the United Nations and its specialized agencies, including the IMF, the World Bank Group, UNESCO, and the WHO. The goal is to build world government step by step, with the UN at the helm.

The effects of globalism manifest themselves in many forms, including manufacturer offshoring, unstable supply chains, higher taxes, higher prices, depressed wages, and much more government control. Yet, the most damaging effect of globalism is a loss of sovereignty. The more control government has, the less you have. And the more control international government gains, the less sovereignty individual countries have.

The Founding Fathers gave us a *limited* government under the Constitution, with a series of checks and balances.

President Trump echoed this idea in many of his speeches, including one before the UN General Assembly in 2018: "That is why America will always choose independence and cooperation over global governance, control, and domination."

One tool globalists use to implement their designs is mass migration, which is an effective means to change a country from within. Millions of illegal aliens cannot be absorbed without serious consequences, including a great increase in crime, disease, and the size of the welfare state. Eventually, the changed demographics will bring large shifts in voting patterns reflective of the governments of the countries the migrants came from.

Texas Governor Greg Abbott and his fellow Texans are experiencing this firsthand. The waves of migrants streaming into Texas are part of an organized invasion created by nongovernmental organizations, lack of enforcement of federal immigration law, and federal policies inviting illegals.

Recently, Governor Abbott demonstrated what a determined state can do. With the support of the

electorate, the governor and state legislators made illegal immigration a state crime. Armed with this legal authority, and considering the fact that the federal government was not fulfilling its constitutional duty to repel an invasion, Texas began controlling its southern border, including laying out razor wire and installing floating barricades in the Rio Grande to deter illegal crossings.

The federal government sued Texas and, unbelievably, the U.S. Supreme Court supported the Biden administration. However, Texas is defying the ruling by preventing U.S. Border Patrol agents from removing the wire and other obstacles. It's also bolstering its state military. More than two dozen states have pledged support for Texas.

Texas' actions offer hope in an otherwise depressing environment in which an ignorant, compliant citizenry seems ready to obey the rule of dictators instead of the rule of law.

The Founding Fathers understood human nature, and bound would-be tyrants from mischief with the chains of the Constitution. Only an informed, educated electorate understands the principles of limited government, and they are able to pressure elected officials to ensure they are working within those limitations.

While some act and speak as though stopping globalism is impossible, this does not reflect reality. Such people merely get in the way of those who are actually doing something to fight back.
