Disarming Americans

Socialist governments are highly oppressive and cannot risk an angry, armed citizenry. Knowing that criminals ignore gun laws, fascist governments use gun control to restrict and suppress normally peaceful people who are not a threat to public safety. Fascists traditionally have used two main tactics: 1) registering and/or licensing gun owners, and 2) limiting the selection and/or availability of guns and ammunition.

An insidious new tactic has been developed in the United States: prosecuting people for using a gun for self-defense. In July 2020, thugs violently broke in to Mark and Patricia McCloskey's gated neighborhood and verbally threatened to kill them and burn their house. The government prosecuted the McCloskeys, not the thugs, simply for holding guns to defend their home against this violent mob. In August 2020, Kyle Rittenhouse had to defend himself against several violent, rioting thugs who chased

him and assaulted him — and even pointed a gun at him. Only when attacked did he shoot, purely in self-defense.

As with the McCloskeys, the government prosecuted Rittenhouse for defending himself, even claiming that having a gun negates a self-defense claim! Malicious government prosecution with unlimited resources warns peaceful people that using a gun to defend oneself against violent thugs may ruin your finances and even your life.
