### UN Official Calls for Worldwide Reduction of Fossil Fuel Usage

"The world's governments must step up, taking rapid and immediate steps to close the fossil fuel production gap and ensure a just and equitable transition."

As executive director of the United Nations Environment Program, **Inger Andersen** wants to see more wind and solar power over the next three dec-ades. Along with researchers at the Stockholm Environment Institute, she envisions seeing net zero emissions of greenhouse gases by the year 2050.


## Congressman Kicked Off Twitter for Refusing to Call a Man a Woman
