President Biden Embraces NATO's Principle of Collective Security

By claiming that the commitment to NATO's Article 5 is "sacred," Biden is demonstrating his desire to have the United States go to war to defend any of the other 29 NATO countries that may be attacked. This principle of collective security undermines the U.S. Constitution, which grants to Congress — not the president, not NATO, and not NATO's UN parent — the power to declare war.
