

Minutes into a news conference at this year's NATO summit in Washington, D.C., President **Joe Biden** mistakenly called Vice President Kamala Harris by the wrong name. "Mr. Trump is unfit for our nation's highest office."

Once a New York Times and CNN contributor who complimented House J6 Committee vice chair Liz Cheney (R-Wyo.) and condemned Trump followers as "MAGAts," Senator **J.D.
