Many of these videos can be found at <u>TheNewAmerican.com</u>, on the streaming *TNA* app in the Play Store (still working on Apple), and through the Roku player. Alex names the movers and shakers and what they are up to. He also reveals details from whistleblowers that add further credibility to what The John Birch Society has been exposing since 1958: that there is an active conspiracy organized against the land of the free and the home of the brave.

Daniel's show is a twice-weekly deep dive into history, exposing Deep State machinations of the past and drawing parallels with their efforts today.

For those who prefer to watch a video over reading or listening to audio while driving, *The New American* offers these in-depth resources for free. Some *TNA* hosts are now sharing livestreams and behind-the-scenes posts on the Locals platform at <u>Locals.com</u>. Rumble owns this platform, so, for the time being at least, it is insulated from cancel culture. Those who sign up on Locals have the option of being a paid supporter or a free user. Some posts are designated only for paid supporters.

A recent example is *TNA* Senior Editor Rebecca Terrell's livestream of a few videos on <u>Locals.com</u> while attending the Moment of Truth conference hosted by Mike Lindell. As soon as she started livestreaming, Locals sent out an automatic email notifying supporters and users to tune in. Those who did were able to see some of the coverage days before content was published at <u>TheNewAmerican.com</u>.

Fans of *The New American* can expect more of this to come as staff continues growing the content and media offerings. Yet, merely knowing what is really going on is only part of the equation to save this country. The next step is boots-on-the-ground action.

John Birch Society founder Robert Welch noted that education without action leads to frustration. America's Founding Fathers demonstrated that patriotism is not a spectator sport. We must take action of some degree to help thwart the enemy's advance. At JBS, we think of the work we do as a balance


