The Real "Fake News"

"Fake News!" "Fake News!" It has been deliciously amusing to behold the unmitigated hypocrisy of left-wing politicians and their establishment media collaborators expressing hysterical alarm over the supposed existential crisis posed by "fake news." This new fixation since the November 8 elections bespeaks desperation and panic among the would-be ruling elites.
