Who's Building the Future?

Addressing political and economic powers in Davos in 2022, World Economic Forum (WEF) Chairman Klaus Schwab proclaimed, "The future is not just happening. The future is built by us, by a powerful community as you here in this room."

Behind this vision lies a dystopian reality that surpasses the aspirations of past dictators and tyrants. With the advent of modern technology, absolute control over every individual on Earth becomes an alarming possibility.

But there's more: The WEF boldly states that achieving the UN's Sustainable Development Goals could lead to a significant reduction in the global population, projecting a figure as low as 6.3 billion people by 2100. In other words, the globalist elites seek a world with fewer inhabitants.

The Great Awakening

As totalitarian as they were, the unprecedented Covid policies unleashed as a part of the Great Reset have become a blessing in disguise, as a powerful eye-opener as to how profoundly corrupt and ill-intentioned governments around the globe are — and have been.

"Some people kind of go through a phase where they have this notion that corruption was recent because they became aware of it recently. But I think many of you have realized that corruption was going on for as long as you've been practicing, for as long as you've been serving, you just didn't see it," said international educator Darren Deojee, adding, "As you look beyond the immediate fire that you're facing, there are many fires burning."

And what are these "fires"? They are pharmaceutical drugs that keep people sick; "fake foods" and insect diets; transhumanism and AI; the disastrous "climate change" agenda; central bank digital currencies; endless wars; censorship and propaganda as totalitarian mechanisms of thought control; and globalist attempts to centralize and weaponize healthcare.

Once you are aware of all these fires, make sure to extinguish them. Merely acknowledging the issues won't do much to save you.

Speaking with *The New American*, Neil Oliver, a popular British TV presenter, author, and master of ceremonies of the conference, described how he felt "desperately let down" by almost all of the influential figures he regarded as "heroes" before Covid "because they had not stepped up and said or done anything" to fight the onslaught against liberty. Being politically indifferent for most of his life, Oliver admitted that once the Covid debacle began, he felt "bad" for not being more engaged long before it started.

The idea of working to create a better future was voiced by many other keynote speakers and served as a motif for the event.

"This is a beautiful event, but if we go home on Monday, wherever home is, and we don't do anything, then we just sat there all weekend, patting each other on the back, saying, 'We are the enlightened ones,'" noted independent journalist and Houston mayoral candidate Derrik Broze, author of the book *How to Opt-Out of the Technocratic State*.

Existential Threats

There are many reasons for creating a better way as an alternative to what the global elites have in mind, but the most crucial one is the need to combat the elites' profound anti-humanism.

A gala dinner on the evening before the first day of the conference opened with a message from Holocaust survivor and human-rights advocate Vera Sharav, who reminded the audience how rapidly human-rights abuses can descend into genocide. "We are once again confronted by a real existential danger from which there will be no escape," she warned. The message was accompanied by the trailer of the recently published five-part documentary *Never Again Is Now Global*, in which Vera and fellow Holocaust survivors and their family members draw undeniable parallels between the totalitarian policies of Nazi Germany and the Covid mandates.

Depopulation and eugenics were also recognized as threats, for example, during a session dubbed "From Climate Change to Nature Nurture."

Describing the practical implementation of carbon "Net Zero" climate goals adopted by 70 countries, including China, the United States, and the European Union, Professor Emeritus Norman Fenton of the U.K. maintained that "apart from the extreme limitations on personal freedom and travel," the plan would "also mean either a colder and hungrier population or massive depopulation."

Speaking with *The New American*, Professor Fenton elaborated, saying that since we lack the technology to effectively capture carbon from the atmosphere, both food and energy production would have to be drastically curtailed in order to reduce atmospheric CO₂ levels, and there simply wouldn't be enough food and energy for all of us.

And the massive die-off the elites envision is already happening.

The central topic of the panel discussion dubbed "From Big Pharma to Real Health" was dedicated to the excess mortality occurring in Western nations across all age groups. For context, here are some key numbers, as reported by UnHerd:

Covid death rates, overall excess deaths in all age groups in Europe in 2022 were as high as in 2020 and higher than 2021 — even in the oldest cohorts. Beyond Europe, the situation is much the same: Australia and New Zealand recorded, respectively, 16% and 9% more excess deaths than the historical average in 2022, while in the United States, CDC data shows that the rate of non-Covid excess deaths in the first half of 2022 was even higher than in 2020 or 2021.

While there is no single explanation for this phenomenon, healthcare agencies in the United States attribute the uptick to Covid and call these "indirect pandemic deaths."

The speakers had a different view on the disturbing developments, and were not at all baffled as to why they were happening.

Pointing out the unprecedented rate of mortality among working-age Americans aged 18 to 64 and a dropping life expectancy over the past three years, Dr. Pierre Kory of the Front Line COVID-19 Critical Care Alliance (FLCCC) called the situation a "humanitarian catastrophe" that exploded in 2021. "You have to ask yourself, what made these workplaces and corporate offices so toxic and deadly?" Dr. Kory said, adding that on top of people dying in their prime, "millions of Americans have landed on disability since vaccine rollout." He called the Covid-19 vaccines "the most toxic and lethal medical intervention ever promulgated in history."

While Dr. Kory called the Covid vaccines a "failed experiment," Dr. Meryl Nass disagreed, maintaining that the U.S. government "knew exactly what they were doing" when rolling out these products on a massive scale, and knew what spike protein would do to the human body since coronavirus research had been funded since 1999.

"Mass poisoning" is how Dr. Mark Trozzi described the rollout of Covid-19 injections on a global scale. (The New American)



Speaking with *The New American*, Canadian Dr. Mark Trozzi, a member of the steering committee of the WCH, referred to the Covid vaccination campaign as "mass poisoning." By all means, humanity needs to reject all future mRNA-based vaccines, including those for livestock, said Professor Karina Acevedo-Whitehouse of Mexico.

Population control is not new, and has been going on for many decades. Today, however, it can be carried out with the help of cutting-edge technology that would result in not only a much smaller population, but a fully controllable one as well.

In her speech on "From AI and Transhumanism to Being Human," Sharav pointed out "a continued series of stealth population reduction experiments [that] were conducted on unsuspecting people, primarily in economically underdeveloped countries," stressing that today, "this genocidal objective is global." She called the transhumanist desires of enhancing human ability and implementing a technocracy the main drivers of "eugenics on steroids." She warned of the possibility of the establishment of a two-tier society in which the majority of the population would be biologically controlled by an elite master class.

"Make no mistake," stressed British entrepreneur Laura Aboli, "the final goal is to eradicate humanity as we know it." To accept this dystopian, post-human future, people have been subjected to decades-

long psychological conditioning, biological tampering, cultural grooming, and educational prepping, she said. Alluding to the false promises of transhumanism, Aboli pleaded, "We are not here to become God. We are here for God to experience life through us."

The closing discussion, titled "From One Health to Our Health," exposed how the World Health Organization (WHO) is constructing a legal infrastructure for a one-world government. This elitist dystopian vision is being facilitated through the insidious "One Health" approach woven into legally binding amendments to the International Health Regulations and the Pandemic Accord, both of which are currently in the works. Should these documents be adopted by governments worldwide, the consequences would be nothing short of catastrophic, as they would effectively surrender national sovereignty to the WHO.

All in all, revelations brought forth during three intense days of enlightening presentations and discussions have revealed a stark truth: It is now abundantly clear that our survival as free individuals and free nations necessitates a decisive and unwavering course of action.

In order to safeguard our very existence and secure a future worth living, the attendees were encouraged to adopt a resolute stance. The time for passive observation has long passed. The recipe for a better way can be distilled to these steps: Practice and defend individual sovereignty; assume personal responsibility for your life, health, and overall well-being; do not waver in your commitment to your core moral values, regardless of the immediate sacrifices that may be demanded; and practice peaceful noncompliance with dictatorial policies. With God's help and unyielding determination, there is a better future.
