Government-caused Housing Problems

Crossroads

The progressive Left has placed America at the crossroads between anarchy and a constitutional republic. The guilty parties run the Democratic gamut: MoveOn.org, Black Lives Matter, Occupy Wall Street, and Democratic congressional representatives. When Representative Maxine Waters (D-Calif.) tells audiences to physically "attack," "harass," and "push back" elected and appointed Republican officials, she is inciting to riot. When Alexandria Ocasio-Cortez incites teenaged boys to attack the president, yet
