# **Myth of Multiculturalism**

In short, Americans need to stay united in their commonalities and make an aliyah back to America.



## **Clinton the Criminal**

It brought back a memory of a similar and perhaps even more egregious example of President Clinton's treasonous actions.

In the early '90s, large donations to the Democratic National Committee were received from Bernard Schwartz of Loral Corporation, as well as Johnny Chung, an aggregator of money from sources including a member of the highest level of the Communist Party in China. In 1996, despite the objections of the State Department, the Judicial Department, and the intelligence agencies, Bill Clinton personally transferred responsibility for approving satellite-export licensing from the State Department (which had refused to approve satellite transfers because the technology was secret and could be used by enemy nations such as China to improve their rockets and better target America) to the Commerce Department. A transfer of a Loral satellite was promptly approved. Also, before this time, as Clinton received campaign donations from the Communist Chinese, he personally signed waivers allowing satellite technology to be exported to China.

In *The Phyllis Schlafly Report*, it is noted: "The fact that Clinton personally issued the waivers to allow shipments of U.S. technology that greatly improved the accuracy and reliability of Communist China's missiles is grounds for impeachment, regardless of whether or not there was any quid pro quo for those decisions."
