



Biblical Basis of Bill of Rights

In this interview with The New American's Alex Newman, Liberty Christian Fellowship Pastor Earl Wallace explains that the Founding Fathers' understanding of God-given rights, including those listed in the Bill of Rights, was a thoroughly biblical view based on what God revealed in the Bible.
