Despite Sexual-assault Allegations, Prominent Democrats Line Up Behind Biden

On Tuesday, former Secretary of State and First Lady Hillary Clinton joined the chorus of Democrats who have endorsed former Vice President Joe Biden for the presidency in 2020. Clinton joins several prominent female Democrats who have chosen to support Biden despite a <u>credible sexualassault allegation</u> against the former Delaware senator, which allegedly occurred in 1993.

Clinton made her announcement after teasing it on <u>Twitter</u> hours before a virtual town hall hosted by Biden, where Clinton said, "I want to add my voice to the many who have endorsed you to be our president."

But yet, what I see now is someone enabling a sexual predator and it was my former boss, Joe Biden, who raped me," Reade told Fox News. We don't need that for our new generation coming up that wants institutional rape culture to
