



Newsom's 28th Amendment Proposal Draws More Criticism

California Governor Gavin Newsom [proposed](#) adding a 28th Amendment to the United States Constitution last week focused on ending "America's Gun violence crisis."

"Our ability to make a more perfect union is literally written into the Constitution," Newsom said in a [press release](#). "So today, I'm proposing the 28th Amendment to the United States Constitution to do just that. The 28th Amendment will enshrine in the Constitution common sense gun safety measures that Democrats, Republicans, Independents, and gun owners overwhelmingly support — while leaving the 2nd Amendment unchanged and respecting America's gun-owning tradition."

Newsom's release stated:

The 28th Amendment will permanently enshrine four broadly supported gun safety principles into the U.S. Constitution:

- Raising the federal minimum age to purchase a firearm from 18 to 21;
- Mandating universal background checks to prevent truly dangerous people from purchasing a gun that could be used in a crime;
- Instituting a reasonable waiting period for all gun purchases; and
- Barring civilian purchase of assault weapons that serve no other purpose than to kill as many people as possible in a short amount of time — weapons of war our nation's founders never foresaw.

Additionally, the 28th Amendment will affirm Congress, states, and local governments can enact additional common-sense gun safety regulations that save lives.

The proposed amendment, according to Newsom, "will require a convention to propose amendments to the United States Constitution, also known as an Article V Convention or amendatory convention."

Newsom quickly received well-deserved criticism. The NRA [tweeted](#), "Newsom's latest publicly [likely publicity] stunt once again shows that his unhinged contempt for the right to self-defense has no bounds. California is a beacon for violence because of Newsom's embrace of policies that champion the criminal and penalize the law-abiding. That is why the majority of Americans rightfully reject his California-style gun control."

California Congressman and Speaker of the House Kevin McCarthy [tweeted](#): “Hey Governor Newsom, The 2nd Amendment already exists—we don’t need a 28th. But what we do need is for Presidential aspirants to stop pushing their extreme positions nationally.”
