



## “Transgender” Former N.H. State Rep. Collared for Kiddie Porn

Something must have tainted the water in New Hampshire’s state House District 31 — they twice elected a “transgender” “woman” with a lengthy rap sheet to represent them. This week, cops arrested him on kiddie porn charges.

Police collared Stacie-Marie Laughton, a man who pretends he is a woman, and charged him with four felony counts of distributing images of kids.

Yet, as with the arrest of former Biden nuclear waste official Sam Brinton for a series of airport luggage thefts, Laughton’s landing in the slammer is no surprise.

If he were any nuttier, he’d identify as a legume.

### Child Porn Charges

Details are sketchy on the latest arrest.

“The case came to light on Tuesday when officers were sent to a local facility for a juvenile matter,” [Nashua’s Patch reported](#):

“They spoke with reporting parties that indicated Laughton distributed sexually explicit images of children,” [Sgt. John Cinelli, the public information officer for the Nashua Police Department] said. “Detectives from the special investigations division were assigned to further the investigation. They applied for and were granted a warrant for Laughton’s arrest.”

Laughton was initially charged with one count but then three more distribution charges were added later. [He] was held on preventative detention and was scheduled for arraignment in Hillsborough County Superior Court-South on Friday.

Strangely, the cops also bagged another individual on kiddie porn charges the same day. An employee at a day care center took nude photos of kids there and sent them to someone else.

A woman named Lindsay Groves, Patch reported, photographed “prepubescent children in a private bathroom and then sent the photos to [an individual with whom she was previously in an intimate relationship] via text message.”

### Criminal Past

The latest allegations notwithstanding, voters should have known better than to send Laughton — real name, Barry — to represent them in the Granite State’s House of Representatives. He is, in a word, a

wacko. And a dangerous one at that.

Before Barry began his illustrious career as the first tranny elected to a state legislature, he was a credit-card fraudster, having been convicted of conspiracy to commit that crime.

That was 2008. From there, his story gets better.

In 2012, he won election to the state House, but when his criminal conviction surfaced after voters went to the polls, he resigned.

“A special election was scheduled a few weeks later, and Laughton signed up to run again,” [Patch reported](#). “However, officials determined [he] was ineligible to hold public office, according to state law, because [he] had not completed [his] sentence,” which “included a 10-year good behavior clause and a restitution requirement.”

In 2015, Laughton called in a bomb threat to the Southern New Hampshire Medical Center, a crime he blamed on his mental illness.

“I guess this was my worst break with it,” [Laughton told](#) the *New Hampshire Union Leader*. “I was untreated for a long time, and I didn’t have medication ... I wasn’t trying to hurt anyone, and it was totally out of character for me.”

One would think voters would have known Laughton was missing a few buttons because he ran thither and yon claiming he was a woman and threatened to bomb a hospital. Nope. They sent him back to the House in 2019 in what might be history’s most remarkable case of the triumph of hope over experience.

“[Laughton] was arrested in July 2021 on seven counts of penalty for false information, accused of misusing the state’s 911 texting system,” [Patch reported](#).

Reelected in November 2022, he resigned after being arrested for stalking a woman in Hudson:

The stalking incidents occurred in late August 2022 and [Laughton] was arrested in early September. [He] was able to keep the arrest under wraps and away from voters, and easily placed second in the primary. [He] was arrested again after the November election.

## Tranny Madness

Laughton is just the latest sex deviant to have become famous in politics and then be revealed as a criminal.

More notorious is the case of Sam Brinton, [whom Joe Biden hired](#) to help run the country’s nuclear waste program. Working as deputy assistant secretary in the Office of Spent Fuel and Waste Disposition at the Energy Department, Brinton showed up to work in heels, lipstick, and dresses.

Brinton’s criminal forté is stealing luggage.

In May, [cops collared](#) the bald, “non-binary” sadist for stealing luggage at Ronald Reagan Airport in 2018. More recently, he was caught stealing luggage in Minneapolis and at Harry Reid International Airport in Las Vegas.

Aside from being involved in a perversion called “pup play,” which involved a master, Brinton, and another individual who plays the “pup,” Brinton favors underage homosexual prostitution.

When federal authorities raided a homosexual prostitution website called Rentboy, [Brinton turned](#) a shade of red that Revlon should have tried to copyright for its palette of lipstick colors.
