In other stories, the Biden administration is spending piles of money on giant CO₂ air vacuums, and the Maui fires have ignited the usual climate-change claptrap.

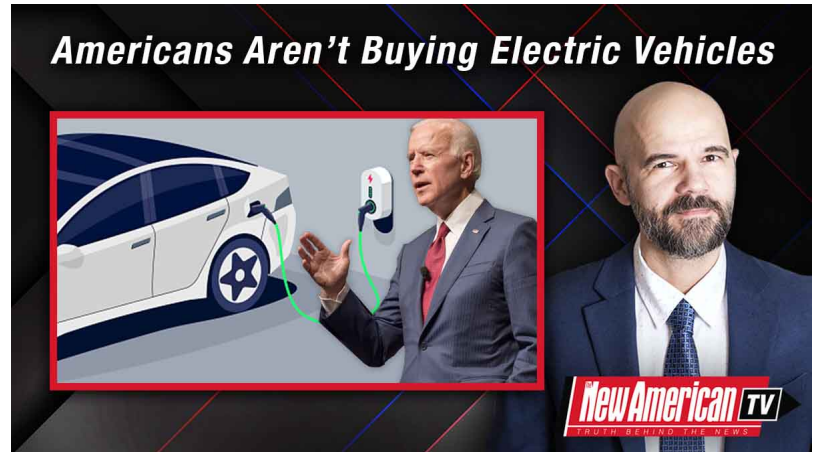
