A constitutional convention under Article V of the U.S. Constitution, sometimes referred to as a “[Convention of States](#)” by proponents, could end up overturning the U.S. Constitution and paving the way for a technocratic form of government, warned leading technocracy expert Patrick Wood. Among the reasons he is sounding the alarm: When he was working on a book with Stanford historian Antony Sutton about the Trilateral Commission, he found out numerous technocracy experts such as Zbigniew Brezinski were calling for just such a convention to facilitate the transition. Wood, the founder and director of [Citizens for Free Speech](#), also warned that it could put crucial freedoms—including the right to freedom of expression—at risk.
