Biblical Worldview & Christian Education: Real & Fake

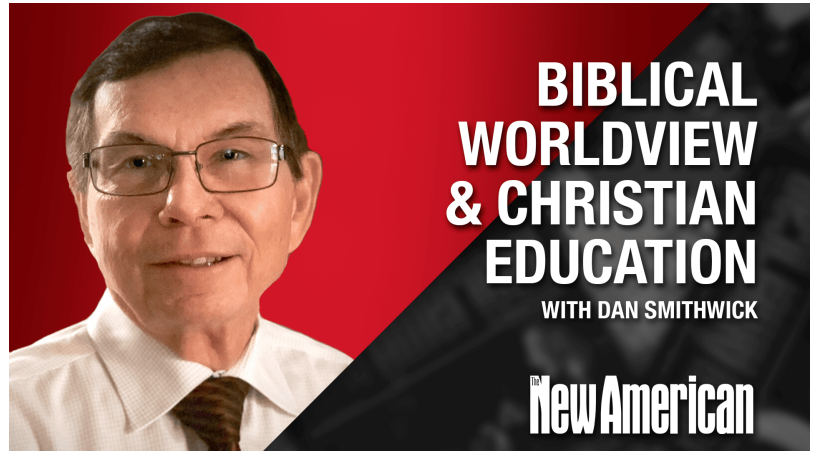
