Threats to Religious Liberty, Foreign & Domestic: Sam Brownback

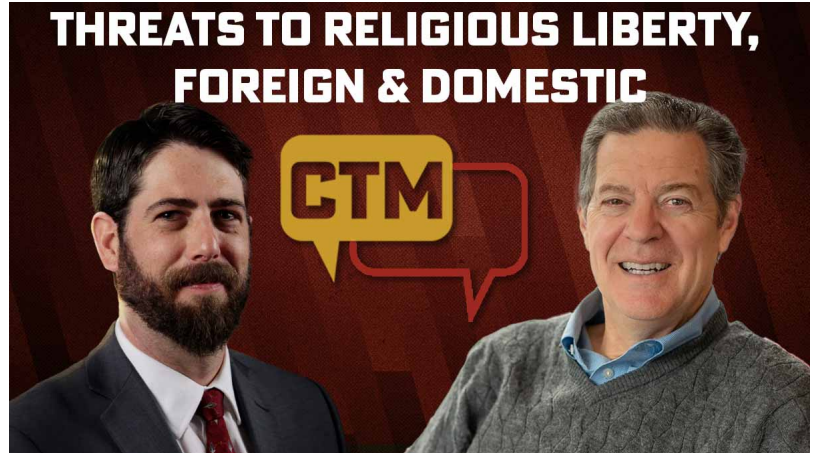
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The threats to religious freedom are growing not just around the world but even in the United States, warned International Religious Freedom Ambassador and former Kansas Governor Sam Brownback in this interview on Conversations That Matter with The New American magazine's Alex Newman.



Brownback, who serves as co-chair of the International Religious Freedom Summit and chairman of the National Committee for Religious Freedom, said Communist China was ruthlessly working to suppress any religious movement independent of the Communist Party. This includes brutal treatment of Christians, Falun Gong followers, Uigur Muslims, and Tibetan Buddhists.

But even on American soil, former U.S. Senator and governor Brownback warned that major threats remain.
