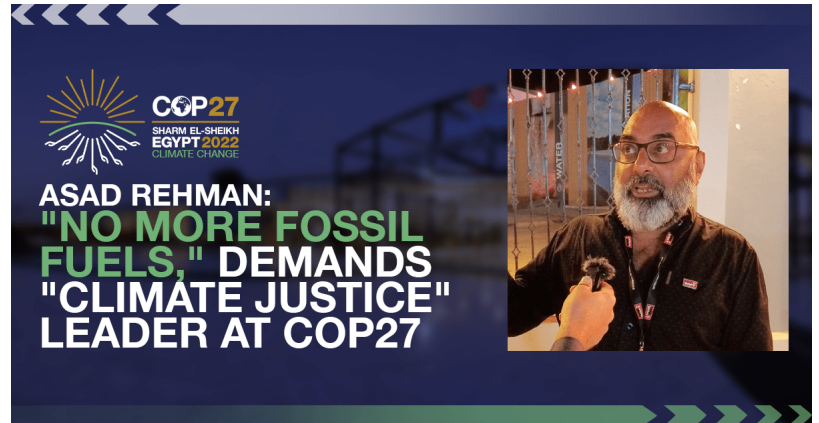

SHARM EL-SHEIKH, EGYPT—It is time for the world to stop using fossil fuels because Pakistan has flooding and the global climate is changing, and billionaires should hand over their money to pay for the damage, said [War on Want](#)’s Asad Rehman, who was helping to coordinate the “climate justice” protesters at the [UN COP27](#) climate summit. In this interview with The New American magazine’s Alex Newman, Rehman compared rich countries’ economic development to burning down other people’s houses. Fossil fuel lobbyists are responsible for stopping “progress” on climate, he added.
