Scott Schara: New Medical Freedom Trial may be on the Horizon

Scott Schara has filed a [motion](#) for a new trial after losing his first suit regarding his teen daughter's death in a Covid hospital in Wisconsin in 2021. She had Down syndrome, and her parents believe she was targeted for destruction on that account.



In June they lost their [civil case](#) against St. Elizabeth Hospital in Appleton and against the doctor and nurse in charge of Grace's care. Scott is now petitioning the circuit court of Outagamie County for a new trial based on evidence he says has recently come to light.
