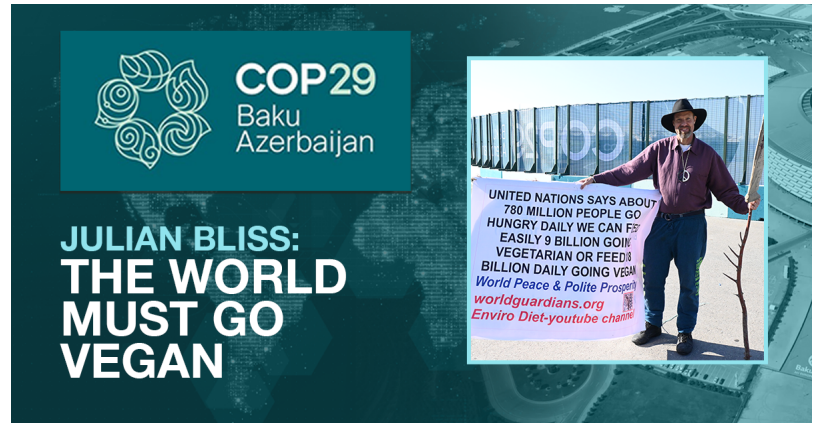
Bliss said to Americans that if Trump is smart, he will help move citizens away from eating steaks, and encourage plant-based meat consumption.
