



## Ukrainian General Blasts Zelensky Corruption, Push for Totalitarianism

Ukrainian President Volodymyr Zelensky has packed his government at the highest levels with corrupt officials and even Russian intelligence operatives from the FSB, and the U.S. intelligence apparatus as well as Ukrainians know all about it, warned Ukrainian General Serhiy Krivonos (ret.) in this interview with The New American magazine's Alex Newman on Conversations That Matter.
