



UN Denies Its Power Grab Is an Attack on Sovereignty

Reporting on the ground at the United Nations' (UN) headquarters for The Summit of the Future, The New American's Alex Newman pressed the UN Secretary General's spokesman, Stéphane Dujarric, on Congress' pushback against the UN and the World Health Organization through House Bill 6645 and Senate Bill 3428, both labeled the "DEFUND Act."
