UN Summit A “Massive Redistribution Scheme,” Says Policy Analyst

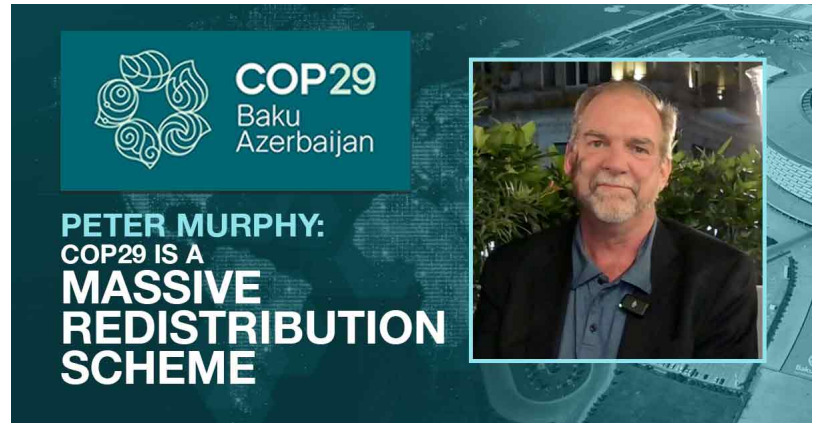
