How does this happen? Walter presents the following explanation and warning:

The screenshot shows a social media post from a user named **Bonchie** (@bonchieredstate) with a verified account. The post text reads: "Because the point of Islam is to conquer, and they've learned they can weaponize Western liberal fears of 'bigotry' to execute that goal." Below the post is a reply from **Craig's Mum 3** (@Elizabe13014545) which says: "Muslims comprise only around 7% of the UK population. Can anyone explain why they are being allowed to exert so much influence over the rest of the country? Halal meat, guidance to schools on dance, banks now recognise Islamic finance principles, Sharia councils etc etc." The post is dated 6:01 AM on Mar 12, 2026, and has 4.5K likes. There are buttons for Reply and Copy link, and a link to read 59 replies.

“Pray to God for England and the rest of the United Kingdom,” Walter then concludes, “as they’ve clearly forgotten who brung them to the dance, are under verbal and physical attack, and may not survive. Quite literally.” The commentator then closes with the below.

This brings us back to Churchill. Reporting on his currency demotion, commentator Andrea Widburg implies that his actual "sin" is something he wrote back in 1899. As she [relates](#), quoting from his book *The River War*:

How dreadful are the curses which Mohammedanism lays on its votaries! Besides the fanatical frenzy, which is as dangerous in a man as hydrophobia [rabies] in a dog, there is this fearful fatalistic apathy. The effects are apparent in many countries. 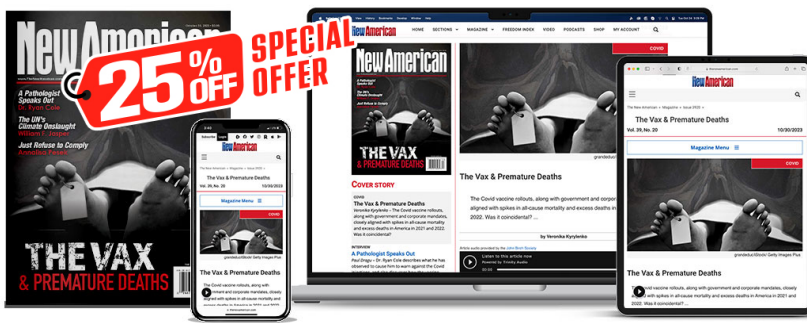


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
