



In Germany, "Poster Boy" for "Migrants" Raped His Mother

Criminal "migrants" and "refugees" in Germany, Austria, and elsewhere in Europe specialize in rape, and they usually rape European girls and women, a form of sexual jihad.

What led to the latest terrible rape is unclear, but the crime is all too familiar. Yet in this case, the victim wasn't a European.

A German court has convicted a Congolese "refugee" of raping his mother.

Victim regardless, ever since the mass migration of Third World refugees to Europe, rape has become a major problem. For some time, European women heave-been terrified to leave home at night for fear of being harassed and sexually assaulted.

"A Congolese refugee, previously described by the German press as a success story for integration, has been jailed for nine years after being convicted of beating and raping his own mother," Remix reported:

Moise Lohombo, 30, was sentenced by the Wiesbaden District Court for an offense the judge claimed was so cruel he told the court he thought he had misread the case file.

The migrant was found to have committed the crime in an apartment he shared with his mother shortly after being released from prison for a drug-related offense.

Upon the return home of his mother, he threatened her with a knife and told her he would kill her if she refused him sex. In a desperate plea, his mother offered him money for a prostitute instead, but he refused.

The violent sex fiend beat his mother so badly that cops found blood sprayed across the apartment. Lohombo left his mother with a brain bleed, and she worried that he left her pregnant.

And, wouldn't you know it, the leftist German media, which never met a "refugee" it didn't like, had presented Lohombo as a hero before he raped his mother and beat her to a bloody pulp, Remix noted:

Lohombo had become a poster boy in Germany for how migrants could successfully integrate into Western society and transform their lives.

Having arrived in Europe at the age of 8, the child migrant already had problems with aggression and would attack other children. With a long rap sheet in his youth, the

Congolese national was portrayed as someone who had turned their life around, completing an apprenticeship as a baker before turning to professional boxing.

"If you sit across from Moise Lohombo over a latte, you see a charming, friendly young man who enthusiastically shows pictures of his bull terrier dog Betty on his cell phone," read a puff piece on the man in <u>Deutsche Handwerkszeitung</u> back in 2017.

Lohombo, the newspaper reported, had a tough life of "ups and downs," and "literally fought his way" back from being a violent, dangerous criminal. In the media's version of Lohombo's life, he abandoned his "youthful sins" to become a good German, Remix continued.

But not for long. He landed in prison on drug charges, but was paroled on August 25, 2023.

"During sentencing [for the rape], the judge told the court he thought he had misread the case file upon reviewing the circumstances of the offense," Remix reported:

"How can something like this happen?" he asked.

Lohombo's only response throughout the trial was that he "did not know how this had happened." In mitigation, his defense lawyer claimed his client had consumed psychogenic substances and alcohol and was not of sound mind during the attack.

That excuse didn't work, and the judge sentenced him to prison for nine years.

Other Rapes

As unusual as that particular "refugee" rape is, most others aren't, and they often involve Afghan "migrants" or "refugees," as *The New American* reported last week.

Indeed, such is the Afghan rape wave that German authorities will punish anyone who dares mention it.

Thus did Marie-Thérèse Kaiser receive a \$6,500 fine for revealing Afghan rape statistics online.

An Alternative for Germany (AfD) party leader from Rotenburg, Kaiser was punished for inciting hatred against local Afghans.

"The charge was based on a post that Kaiser had spread on her social media accounts in August 2021," the *The European Conservative* reported:

In it, she wrote: "Afghanistan refugees; Hamburg SPD mayor for 'unbureaucratic' acceptance; Welcoming culture for gang rape?"

Among other things, the politician linked to an article showing that Afghans in Germany are particularly heavily involved in gang rape.

... The AfD politician justified her concern about uncontrolled immigration with statistics and warned of rapes by "culturally alien masses."

Said Kaiser:

The mere mention of numbers, data, and facts is to be declared a criminal offense simply because the establishment refuses to accept reality. I won't let myself be silenced.

And indeed, the data are clear. An Afghan is 10 times more likely to be a rape suspect than a real German, and almost eight times more likely to be a criminal suspect generally.

The Motive

On New Year's Eve 2015-2016, Arabs and North Africans <u>swept through</u> more than a dozen German cities to sexually assault and/or rape more than 1,200 women, a sexual terror campaign Germany hadn't seen since the Red Army invaded in 1945 <u>and raped</u> "every German female from 8 to 80."

Austrian women are suffering under the same Afghan campaign of sexual jihad.

Writing for The National Interest in 2017, <u>Cheryl Benard summarized</u> what an Afghan friend told her: They "are motivated by a deep and abiding contempt for Western civilization. Europeans are the enemy, and their women are legitimate spoils."

As for the Congolese and the rest of the "migrants" and "refugees" who have invaded Germany, it appears that Germans are awakening.

The populist AfD is gaining in popularity, and now holds 77 seats in the Bundestag, Germany's parliament.
